- One liner describing what changed (not period terminated)
- A few lines describing in more details why things changed
- GPG signed commit

1 How to Write a Git Commit Message

- Separate subject from body with a blank line
- Limit the subject line to 50 characters
- Capitalize the subject line
- Do not end the subject line with a period
- Use the imperative mood in the subject line
- Wrap the body at 72 characters
- Use the body to explain what and why vs. how
